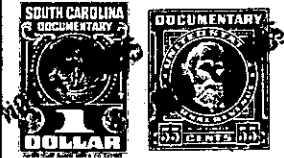

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Fifty (\$350.00) Dollars

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Katie King

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Katie King

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina near the town of Taylors known as Lot Nos. 4 and 5 on a plat of subdivision for Ansel, G. W. and Mrs. J. H. Alewine, Taylors Lumber Company, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book WW at pages 440-441 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint front coners of Lot Nos. 3 and 4 on the eastern side of a paved county highway and running thence along said highway N. 34 E., 100 feet to an iron pin; thence still along said highway N. 50 E., 80 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Hill Drive with the said paved highway; thence along Hill Drive S. 12 E., 52 feet to an iron pin; thence along a branch S. 72-10 W., 40 feet; thence still with said branch S. 24 W., 43 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corners of Lot Nos. 4 and 5; thence still with said branch and along the rear of Lot No. 4 S. 19 W., 76 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of lot Nos. 3, 4, 6, and 7; thence along the line of Lot Nos. 3 and 4 N. 84 W. 143 feet to the point of beginning.
