KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Mrs. Elvie Cooper

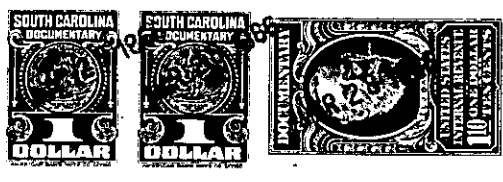
in consideration of One Thousand and No/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars,

This being a portion of the same property of W. M. Guest and Melle G. Guest as surveyed by W. F. Adkins on March 23, 1937, and being more particularly described as follows;
