As part of the consideration for this conveyance, the Grantee assumes and agrees to pay all unpaid and outstanding bonded indebtedness incurred by Taylors Water and Sewer District for or in anyway related to the installation or construction of the District's water system, the amount of which is Two Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand (\$274,000.00) Dollars, and the assumption and agreement to discharge and pay in full within seven (7) years from date in accordance with the respective written agreements as executed with certain parties totaling Two Hundred and Thirty-Three Thousand Six Hundred and Fifty-Nine and 45/100 (\$233,659.45) Dollars, and assumption of that certain promissory note given by Taylors Water and Sewer District to L. H. Tankersley, with an outstanding balance of Twenty Six Thousand and No/100 (\$26,000.00) Dollars.
