interests in certain real estate referred to therein as having been conveyed to Frank E. R. Siena, as Trustee, subject to said Agreement dated September 7, 1962; and

WHEREAS, by said Termination Agreement and deed to James G. Bannon, it was intended that Frank E. R. Siena and Ruth P. Siena be divested of any interest of any nature whatsoever in and to any and all real estate subject to the aforesaid Agreement dated September 7, 1962; and

WHEREAS, by deed dated March 4, 1966 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 793 at page 204, James G. Bannon conveyed the real estate in which he had an interest to The Citizens and Southern National Bank of South Carolina (Greenville, S. C. Branch), as Trustee under written agreement with him dated March 4, 1966; and by deed dated March 4, 1966 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 793 at page 203, Virginia P. Bannon did likewise convey the real estate in which she had an interest to the said Bank, as Trustee under written agreement with her dated March 4, 1966; and

WHEREAS, it is intended by this instrument to confirm the aforesaid divestment of any interest of Frank E. R. Siena and Ruth P. Siena in and to any and all real estate of the said James G. and Virginia P. Bannon, and it is further intended to release, discharge, and convey unto The Citizens and Southern National Bank of South Carolina (Greenville, S. C. Branch), as Trustee under agreement
