All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 26 according to a plat of property of Lloyd Gilstrap prepared by Dean C. Edens, August 10, 1957, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book OO, at pages 66 and 67, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
