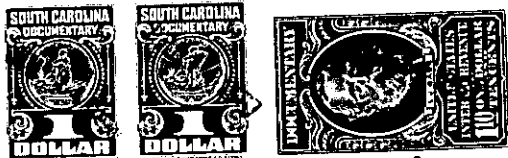
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Daniel Edwin Hunt, Jr. and Mary T. Hunt
