C., acting by and through the Federal Housing Commissioner, (hereinafter referred to as "Grantor"), for and in consideration of the sum of NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY-----DOLLARS (\$ 9,650.00-----), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto **JAMES E. TRAMMELL, JR. AND LINDA M. TRAMMELL**

(hereinafter referred to as "Grantee(s)"), and to the heirs and assigns of said Grantee(s), the following described real estate situate in the County of **GREENVILLE**, State of South Carolina, to wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the northerly side of Crosby Circle, near the City of Greenville, S. C. being known and designated as Lot No. 156 on plat of Paramount Park as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book W, page 57.
