

distribution under the foregoing terms, in the event the Trustor shall, through illness, accident or other unforeseen casualty, be in need of additional funds to supply any care or attention that may be required for her, to be judged of by said Trustee, then said Trustee shall be further authorized and empowered to advance to the Trustor such funds as may be needed for her proper maintenance, care and treatment, and to that end may encroach upon the corpus of said trust property for the purpose of supplying such funds to the full extent necessary, even to the extent of exhausting said trust property, with this right of encroachment not to be exhausted by use, but to be exercisable at any time and from time to time as occasion may require, and with all remainders herein provided specifically made subject to said rights of encroachment.

IV DISTRIBUTION AFTER DEATH OF TRUSTOR.

The Trustor specifically reserves the right to provide by Will for the distribution of the income available for distribution after her death from any portion of said trust property that shall not have been consumed in the proper execution of said trust, to the extent that said income may be attributable to one-half of said trust property, and any provision that she shall make for the distribution of such income from one-half of the remainder of said trust property shall be valid and effective upon the Trustee herein named, in the event the Trustor shall elect to exercise said right. If after the death of the Trustor no Will exercising said right of directing the application of said income shall be probated or filed for probate in the proper probate office having jurisdiction of such Will at the time of the death of the Trustor, within a period of six months from the date of the death of the
