RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT

GREENVILLE COUNTY

THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 23 day of

1967, by and between CITY OF GREENVILLE,

SOUTH CAROLINA and COUNTY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, hereinafter called "Grantor" (whether one or more), and DUKE POWER

COMPANY, a North Carolina corporation, hereinafter called

"Grantee";

WITNESSETH:

That Grantor, in consideration of \$12.370 and paid by Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does grant and convey unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, subject to the limitations hereinafter described, the right to erect, construct, reconstruct, replace, maintain and use towers, poles, wires, lines, cables, and all necessary and proper foundations, footings, crossarms and other appliances and fixtures for the purpose of transmitting electric power and for Grantee's communication purposes, together with a right of way, on, along and in all of the hereinafter described tracts of land lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

Easement #1: Being a strip of land 81 feet wide extending 47 feet on the northerly side and 34 feet on southerly side of a survey line which has been marked on the ground and is approximately 1340.3 feet long and lies across the land of the Grantor (in one or more sections); Easement #2: Being a strip of land 141 feet wide extending 107 feet on the northeasterly side and 34 feet on the southwesterly side of a survey line which has been marked on the ground and is approximately 385.7
