

NOW, Therefore, Know all men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of

Twenty-Seven Hundred Fifty (\$2750.00) and no/100 Dollars,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Edward J. Nasser and Leroy J. Nasser

"All that certain tract, parcel or lot of land, with improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Oneal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

BEGINNING at an iron stake on the South side of Old Log Ford Road (also known as Pine Log Road), said stake being at the eastern end of the Enoree River Bridge, said bridge being one mile East of the intersection of Old Log Road and the Enoree Road which also intersects with Highway 25 at a point $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles West of the intersection of said Log Ford Road. Running from said stake in an Easterly direction 600 feet along Old Log Ford Road to an iron stake, said stake being 686 feet West of light pole No. QJ 19, thence running in a Southerly direction 200 feet to an iron stake; thence running in a Westerly direction 550 feet to an iron stake on the bank of the Enoree River; thence running along the bank of the Enoree River in a Northerly direction 200 feet to the point of the beginning.

Being a portion of that part, parcel or tract of land conveyed to Calvin Brown by deed of Homer Styles, dated the 22nd day of May, 1940, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 222 at Page 106. Above land conveyed to Calvin Brown and Nellie Grover by deed of Calvin Brown dated February 9, 1962 and recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 696, at Page 359."
