M. Dill Property, according to survey by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated November 20, 1945, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING in the center of the road leading from the Batesville Road to the J. R. Green property, joint corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6, and running thence with the Government property line, N. 79-15 E. 270 feet to an iron pin which is 68 feet east of the high-water mark of Enoree River; thence S. 5-45 E. 508 feet to pin at angle, corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 9; thence with line of said lots, S. 73-15 E. 225 feet to center of the road; thence therewith N. 15-05 E. 100 feet to angle; thence with said road, N. 7-05 E. 100 feet to angle and corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8; thence N. 2-35 W. 100 feet to iron pin and angle; thence N. 6-40 W. 331 feet to the beginning corner.
