presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said BERE A. PUBLIC SERVICE DISTRICT
COMMISSION, a body politic under the laws of South Carolina, its
Successors and Assigns Forever:

ALL water lines, mains, valves and appurtenances installed and located
in, under or along Etowah Drive, Cherrylane Drive, Shubuta Drive,
Claxton Drive, Manassas Drive, Delray Circle, Latham Drive and Patricia
Avenue in Farmington Acres Subdivision in the County of Greenville,
State of South Carolina and specifically including approximately 12,345
feet - 6" Pipe; 2,975 feet - 2" Pipe; 27 - 6" Valves; 7 - 2" Valves;
11 - fire hydrants as shown on a drawing entitled "C.A. Talley, J. Frank
Williams, W. N. Leslie, & C. E. Robinson, Jr., Trustee to Berea Public
Service District", attached hereto and made a part of this conveyance.

TOGETHER with all pipes, valves and other mechanical parts and equip-
ment appurtenant to said main and lines and all rights of way and
easements necessary or incident to the operation, maintenance, repair
or replacement of said water main, pipe lines, and appurtenant equipment.

This deed is to confirm the sale and transfer of the property conveyed
hereby originally made on September 19, 1963, March 1, 1965, and November
2, 1965, the original conveyance having been made by the Grantors herein
to Berea Water & Sewer District which by appropriate action is now
known as Berea Public Service District Commission.
