

School District of Greenville County does further warrant that it is the sole owner of such lines; that no other party has any interest of any kind or nature therein; that such lines have been installed in accordance with the requirements of the Mauldin-Simpsonville-Fountain Inn Water District; that such lines, including the cost of installation, have been fully paid for and that the School District of Greenville County has the authority to convey such lines. ~~The School District of Greenville County further agrees to hold harmless Mauldin-Simpsonville-Fountain Inn Water District from any loss in connection with this conveyance.~~

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said water lines, valves, fittings and accouterments to Mauldin-Simpsonville-Fountain Inn Water District, its successors and assigns forever.

Mauldin-Simpsonville-Fountain Inn Water District agrees to pay the sum of Thirteen Thousand and Ten and 05/100 Dollars (\$13,010.05) for such conveyance, such sum to be paid to the School District of Greenville County when the annual revenue to Mauldin-Simpsonville-Fountain Inn Water District from water sold through such lines equals or exceeds One Thousand, Three Hundred and One and no/100 Dollars (\$1,301.00).

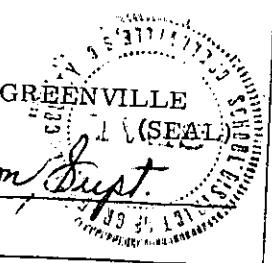
