All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the north side of 7th Street in Section 4 of Judson Mill Village, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot 49 on a plat of Section 4, Judson Mill Village made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, January, 1941, which plat is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book K, at Pages 75 and 76, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of 7th Street, joint front corner of Lots 48 and 49, and running thence with the line of Lot 48 N. 1-42 W. 123 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot 75 S. 88-16 W. 81 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 50 S. 1-42 E. 123.15 feet to an iron pin on the north side of 7th Street; thence with the north side of 7th Street N. 88-10 E. 81 feet to the beginning corner.

This conveyance is made subject to protective covenants, easements and rights-of-way of record.

This is the same property conveyed to Vernon Smith and Ethel B. Smith by deed recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 756, at Page 411, and inherited by the remaining grantors on the death of Vernon Smith who died intestate November 21, 1966, and whose estate was probated in the Office of the Probate Court in Apartment 968, File 10.
