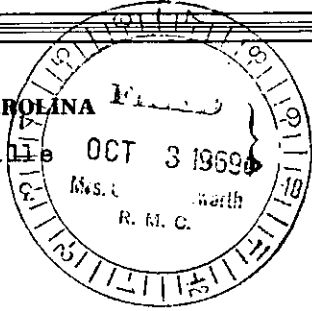

to us Six Hundred in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Gary Wooten

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Gary Wooten and his heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances:

BEGINNING on a point in the No. 11 Highway; thence N. 43-30 E. 341 feet to stake; thence N. 12-30 E. 177 feet to a stake; thence N. 12-30 W. 327 feet to a stake; thence N. 3/4 W. 415 feet to a stake; thence S. 36 W. 872 feet to a point in No. 11 Highway; thence down said road, S. 36-40 E. 540 feet to the beginning corner, containing 7.80 acres, more or less.

This is the same property conveyed to Floyd Morris and Emma Morris by deed of C. S. West, recorded in Deed Book 295, Page 360, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County. The said Floyd Morris died intestate on February 22, 1968, and the grantors herein are his only heirs at law, except Maxine Leigher.
