All that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Greenville Township, on the Southeast side of Rutherford Road, in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 6 on Plat of Rutherford Park made by Dalton & Neves on September 30, 1946, recorded in Plat Book P, at page 109, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southeast side of Rutherford Road, 248.3 feet Northeast from Foster Street, at corner of Lot No. 5, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 34-45 E. 150.2 feet to a stake in line of Lot No. 23; thence with the line of said lot, N. 52-04 E. 30 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 7; thence with the line of said lot, N. 24-50 W. 154 feet to a stake in Rutherford Road; thence with the Southeast side of Rutherford Road, S. 48-07 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

This property is conveyed subject to restrictions, easements and rights of way of record affecting said property.
