KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that JUNIUS H. GARRISON, JR., ROY F. HUNT, JR., A. Foster McKISSICK AND J. COOPER SHACKELFORD, for and in consideration of the premises and for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to us in hand paid by THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon the tract of land located on the Western side of the intersection of South Burty Road and Lenhardt Road, situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, bounded:

On the North by Lenhardt Road, on the East by South Burty Road, and on the South and West by other property of Grantors and is a portion of property conveyed to the Grantors by deed of Peoples National Bank recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 890 at Page 12.

and to construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises, in a proper manner, a pipe line, and other necessary apparatus incident thereto, using the necessary appliances and machinery for such work for the purpose of conveying water through the premises above described, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said pipe line all trees and other obstructions that may in any way endanger or interfere with the proper operation of or access to the same.

It is understood and agreed that the right of way under this deed has a total length of 80 feet and is 30 feet in width measuring 10 feet on the Southwestern side of the center of said pipe line as laid and 20 feet on the Northeastern side of said pipe line as laid. The entire right of way may be used for the purpose of installing a pipe line and no obstructions shall hereinafter
