(2) To divide all profits derived from the holding, managing or disposal of said trust property into forty equal shares, disbursing and paying over same at such times as he may see fit (in no event less than once each twelve months) as follows: 10/40 to H. L. Rosamond; 10/40 to I. H. Philpot; 4/40 to Rex L. Carter; 2/40 to John B. Campbell; 2/40 to N. H. Newton; 2/40 to John L. Newton; 2/40 to N. S. Newton; 2/40 to S. A. Philpot; 1/40 to L. A. Hall; 1/40 to I. Henry Philpot, Jr.; 2/40 to Harold M. Newton; and, 2/40 to A. M. Loudermilk.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said presmises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee hereinabove named, in trust, his successors and assigns.

AND we do hereby bind ourselves, our successors and assigns, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said grantee hereinabove named, his successors and assigns, against ourselves, our successors and assigns, and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
