ALL the right, title and interest of Grover C. Clark, the same being a one-half undivided interest in and to:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown and designated as Tract No. 4 on a plat of property of Grover C. Clark, by J. C. Smith, RLS, made August 1952, recorded in Plat Book DD, page 17 of the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., and having such metes and bounds as shown thereon.

This conveyance is subject to easements and rights of way of record including the right of way for South Carolina Highway No. 418.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to Grover C. Clark and Meddie G. Clark by deed dated January 19, 1949, recorded in Deed Book 371, page 333 of the RMC Office for Greenville County.

This deed is executed and delivered to the grantee in accordance with the terms of the Will of Grover C. Clark whereby the subject property was devised to the grantee, subject to a life estate of Meddie G. Clark, and the Executors were directed to deliver valid deed in fee simple as will appear by reference to Apartment 1126, File 17 of the Probate Court of Greenville County. Meddie G. Clark died October 25, 1970 as will appear by reference to Apartment 1154, File 17 of the Probate Court of Greenville County.
