All that lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot 42 of Morgan Hill on plat thereof recorded in the RMC office for Greenville County in Plat Book A at page 69, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a stake on the south side of Morgan Street at the joint corner of Lots 41 and 42, said corner being approximately 419 feet east from the east side of the Branden Road; thence along said Morgan Street N 82 3/4 E 60 feet to a stake at corner of Lots 42 and 43; thence along the line of the last mentioned lots S 7 1/4 E 200 feet to a stake at the joint corner of Lots 42, 43, 62 and 63; thence N 82 3/4 W 60 feet to the corner of Lots 41 and 42; thence N 7 1/4 E 200 feet to the beginning corner.
