the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto NORVILLE B. SPEARMAN, His Heirs and Assigns, Forever:

All that lot of land situate on the northwest side of Pimlico Road in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot 29 on plat of Section A of Gower Estates, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book QQ, Pages 146 and 147 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of Pimlico Road at the joint front corner of Lots 28 and 29 and runs thence along the line of lot 28, N. 19-14 W. 175 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 70-46 E., 90 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 30, S. 19-14 E. 175 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of Pimlico Road; thence along Pimlico Road S. 70-46 W. 90 feet to the beginning corner.

This conveyance is subject to all restrictions, set back lines, roadways, easements, and rights-of-way, if any, appearing of record, on the premises or on the recorded plat, which affect the property hereinabove described.
