All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the easterly side of Westchester Road, being shown and designated as Lot No. 22, on plat of Pilgrims Point, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "WWW", at Page 35, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the easterly side of Westchester Road, at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 22 and 21, and running thence along the joint lines of said lots S. 88-33 E. 180 feet to an iron pin; running thence S. 1-28 W. 110 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 22 and 23; running thence with the joint lines of Lots Nos. 22 and 23, S. 88-17 W. 180.5 feet to an iron pin on the easterly side of Westchester Road; running thence with the easterly side of Westchester Road, N. 1-28 E. 120 feet to the point of BEGINNING.
