and when any vacancy thereafter occurs the person next in order shall succeed to the vacancy, in the order in which the names appear:

James S. Paget, Jr., Greer, South Carolina John M. Paget, Cumming, Georgia Benjamin L. Paget, Greer, South Carolina

None of the persons above named shall be disqualified by reason of the fact that he may own an interest or share in any of the businesses constituting the original assets of this trust or any assets of the trust hereafter given or transferred to it by the Grantor, nor from participating in any reorganization or rearrangement thereof.

(8) LAW GOVERNING.

Except as hereinabove otherwise provided, this agreement shall be construed in accordance with and the administration of the properties held in trust hereunder shall be determined by the laws of the State of South Carolina irrespective of the domicile or residence of the Grantor or of the situs of any property, real or personal, held in trust hereunder.

(9) SCOPE OF TRUST.

The Grantor reserves unto herself the right from time to time to make additional property, either real, personal, or mixed, a part of this trust estate, by transferring, assigning, delivering, or deeding said property to the Trustee. Upon receipt of said additional property, the same shall be held, managed, and controlled by the Trustee or his successors or successor in accordance with the terms of this trust indenture.
