This Decree is filed pursuant to Petition of the School District of Greenville County.

This action was brought by the School District of Greenville County for the condemnation of real estate for school purposes. The action is authorized by Sections 25-101 through 25-140, commonly called the "Public Works Eminent Domain Law".

It appears from the record that the Court has jurisdiction of the premises and all of the parties are properly before the Court.

A hearing was held by me in the Circuit Court Room of the Greenville County Court House at 10:00 A.M., on May 28, 1971. All parties were present or represented by counsel. All parties admitted that the proceedings were proper and all requirements of the law had been complied with. All parties specifically waived trial by jury and specifically waived referring the matter to a special Master to determine just compensation and agreed that this Court hear the evidence and make a determination of just compensation and fair market value of the property, the subject of this action.
