to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s)

ELWOOD D. HEISEY AND MARY ANNE HEISEY, THEIR HEIRS AND ASSIGNS, FOREVER:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the northerly side of North Garden Circle, being shown and designated as Lot No. 5, on plat of North Garden, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "EE", at Page 63, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northerly side of North Garden Circle, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5, and running thence along line of Lot No. 4, N. 13-47 W. 200 feet to an iron pin; running thence N. 76-13 E. 75 feet to an iron pin; running thence along line of Lot No. 6, S. 13-47 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on the northerly side of North Garden Circle; thence along the northerly side of North Garden Circle, S. 76-13 W. 75 feet to the point of BEGINNING.
