WHEREAS, Dr. John R. Harrison died intestate, owning a 1/2 undivided interest in several lots of land situate in Greenville County, South Carolina, and leaving as his sole heirs at law and distributees, his widow, Inez P. Harrison, the grantor herein, a son, John R. Harrison, Jr., and a daughter, Caroline H. Kiger, all of whom now partition said lots. Inez P. Harrison owned the other 1/2 undivided interest in said lots.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that

I, Inez P. Harrison,
in consideration of said partition, and also

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in consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

John R. Harrison, Jr., His Heirs and Assigns Forever:

All of my undivided right, title and interest in and to:

ALL of those two certain pieces, parcel or lots of land situate, lying and being in or near the City of Greer, in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, designated as Lots Nos. 22 and 23 on plat of J. D. Ashmore lands, sub-divided for H. J. Lanford on November 2, 1925, by H. S. Brockman, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "F" at page 175, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the southern side of Ashmore Street, joint corner of Lots Nos. 21 and 22, and running thence along the southern side of said street N. 78 W. 50 feet to corner of lot No. 23, and continuing on said course another 50 feet to the northwestern corner of said lot No. 23; thence S. 5-20 W. 142 feet to a point at the southwest corner of said lot No. 23; thence S. 72 E. 59.3 feet to corner of said lot No. 22, and continuing on said course another 50.3 feet to corner of lots 22 and 21; thence with line of said lot No. 21, 152.6 feet to the beginning corner.

The undivided right, title and interest in and to the above described property being hereby conveyed were acquired by me through two sources, namely:

- (1) A one-half undivided right, title and interest through the deed from Mrs. W. M. Austin, dated September 6, 1933, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 115 at page 343;
- (2) The balance, rest and residue of my said undivided right, title and interest in said property was acquired by me through inheritance from the said Dr. John R. Harrison, deceased, a co-grantee with me in the Austin deed aforesaid.

together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s), and the grantee(s)'s heirs or successors and assigns, forever. And, the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)'s heirs or successors, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the grantee(s) and the grantee(s)'s heirs or successors and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
