the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto MARY C. RIKARD & GLENN GERALD RIKARD, their heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land together with buildings and improvements situate, lying and being on the Northwestern side of Lowndes Avenue in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown and designated as a portion of Lots Nos. 85 and 86, on a Plat of Dixie Heights, made by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engineer, recorded on January 31, 1937, in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book H, page 46, and having according to a more recent survey of the Property of Glenn Gerald Rikard and Mary C. Rikard made by C. C. Jones, Engineer, dated March, 1972, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Lowndes Avenue, said iron pin being located 42 feet from the intersection of Lowndes Avenue with Lowndes Hill Road and being located 10 feet East of the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 84 and 85 and running thence along the Northwestern side of Lowndes Avenue, N. 45-12 E., 50 feet to an iron pin; thence a line through Lot 86, N. 44-48 W., 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 45-12 W., 50 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 44-48 E., 150 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

The above property is the same conveyed to the Grantor by deed of David H. Lumsden recorded in Deed Book 823, page 296, and is hereby conveyed subject to rights of way, easements, conditions, public roads and restrictive covenants reserved on plats and other instrument of public record and actually existing on the ground affecting said property.

The Grantees agree to pay Greenville County and City of Greenville County property taxes for the tax year 1972 and subsequent years.

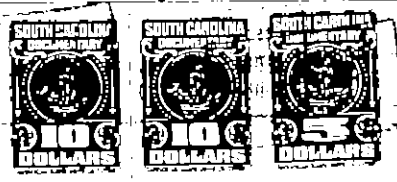
