to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Blaine Joe Williams and Melva A. Williams

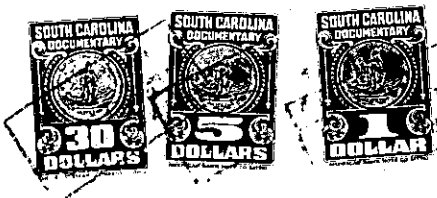
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Blaine Joe Williams and Melva A. Williams and their heirs and assigns forever:

All that lot of land located in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, about two miles West of Greer, on the Southeast side of U.S. Super Highway No. 29, and being shown and designated as Lots Nos. 1 and 2 on a survey entitled "Property of G. B. and Willie Mae Harrill," dated October 14, 1959, by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an old iron pin on the right of way of U.S. Highway 29, joint front corner with property now or formerly of T. D. Elmore, and running thence S. 32-33 E. 92.3 feet to an old iron pin; thence S. 24-23 E. 145.1 feet to an old iron pin; thence N. 66-47 E. 148.4 feet to an old iron pin; thence N. 23-54 W. 208.6 feet to an old iron pin on the right of way of U.S. Highway 29; thence along and with said right of way S. 67-30 W. 150.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 22-30 W. 25 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 67-30 W. 13 feet to the point of beginning.
