

and the exchange of property, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto First Piedmont Corporation, their successors and assigns forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot 2 on the aforesaid plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A at Page 183 and being also known and designated as Lot 2 on a plat of the Property of Josie L. Floyd, et al. recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book SS at Page 187 and having, according to the last-mentioned plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Brown Street, joint front corner of Lots 2 and 3 and running thence along the joint line, S. 55 E. 143 corner of Lots 2 and 3 and running thence along the joint line, S. 55 E. 143 feet to a power pole on the northwestern side of Clairmont Street, now known as Bay Street; thence along the northwestern side of Bay Street, N. 31 E. 53.0 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 1, now or formerly belonging to Biggs; thence along the line of that lot (Following a rock wall for a portion of the distance), N. 55 W. 143.0 feet to an iron pin on the southeastern side of Brown Street; thence along the southeastern side of Brown Street, S. 31 W. 53.0 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to Carrie M. Thompson by two deeds as follows: the first, a deed from Hattie E. Williams, et al. dated August 4, 1939, recorded in the R.M.C.
