in consideration of Thirty-five Thousand and no/100 (\$35,000.00)-----Dollars,

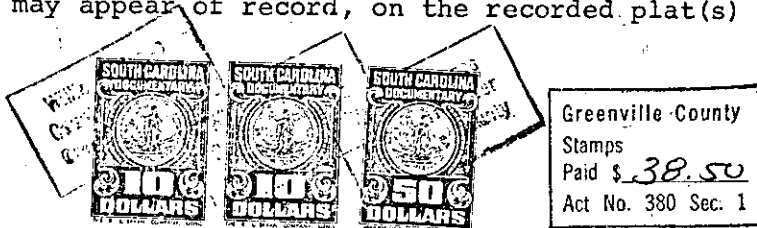
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto
