

Form No. 106-Title to Real Estate by a Corporation

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, on the Southwest side of Alabama Avenue and being shown as Lot No. 107 on Plat of property of Talmer Cordell made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers July 1949 recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "V" at page 198, said Lot fronting 61 feet along the southwest side of Alabama Avenue, running back to a depth of 200 feet on the Southeast side, to a depth of 200 feet on the Southwest side and being 61 feet across the rear.
