BEGINNING At a point in the center of McKittrick Road at the intersection of McKittrick Road and River Road and running thence, N 79-06 W 726.3 feet to an old iron pin; thence turning and running N 4-25 E 475.8 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running, S 80-38 E 979.8 feet along the line of property to be conveyed to Ronald P. Herndon to a point in the center of McKittrick Road; thence S 20-53 W 160 feet; thence S 26-03 W 100 feet to a point; thence S 41-38 W 285 feet to the point of beginning, containing 9.60 acres, more or less. 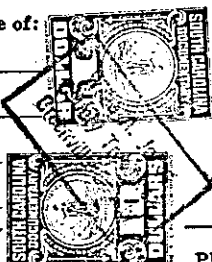
This property is conveyed subject to all easements, restrictions, zoning ordinances and rights of way of record and on the ground which may affect said tract.
