ALL of my right, title, and interest in and to:

ALL that certain piece or parcel of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as the Western half of Lot No. 26, Block B, of Stone Land Company, and having, according to a Plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office in Plat Book A, at Page 341, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Northern side of West Croft Street, which Point is 271.9 feet West of the intersection of West Croft Street with Wilton Street, and running thence N 1-41 E 208 feet to an iron pin; thence N 85-39 W 54.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S 1-41 W 208 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of West Croft Street; thence with the Northern side of West Croft Street S 85-39 E 54.4 feet to the point of beginning.
