RELEASE AND EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that T. Walter Brashier, for and in consideration of the sum of Nineteen Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100 (\$19,500.00) Dollars, to him in hand paid by the South Carolina State Highway Department, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has for himself, his heirs, executors and assigns, released, acquitted and discharged and by these presents does hereby release, acquit and forever discharge the South Carolina State Highway Department, its agents, employees and servants of and from any and all actions, causes of actions, damages or demands of whatsoever name or nature, or in any manner arisen, arising or to grow out of the construction and maintenance of U. S. Highway No. 25 as relocated in the upper section of Greenville County, including access or haul roads thereto, across or adjacent to the property of T. Walter Brashier. This release covers not only the damages alleged by the plaintiff in his certain complaint against the State Highway Department, dated January 17, 1973, as above entitled, but all past, present or prospective damages that might result or be claimed to result from the construction and maintenance of the department's highways, rights of way and drainage facilities, including but not limited to Terry Creek and Beaverdam Creek.

It is further acknowledged that there is no agreement or promise on the part of the highway department to do or omit to do any act or thing not herein mentioned and that the above consideration is in full settlement of any and all damages to the undersigned, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns arising from or out of any and all matters aforementioned.
