in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand and No/100

by the grantees herein quitclaimed

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold/and released, and by these quitclaim presents do grant, bargain, sell'and release unto the said Elizabeth V. Byrd for and during her lifetime and the remainder at her death to the following named persons, their heirs and assigns, forever, in the fractional undivided shares set forth opposite their names: 7/24 to W. Beasley Vaughan; 7/24 to Robert Everette Vaughan; 7/48 to Lynwood B. Vaughan; 7/48 to James Henry Vaughan, Jr.; and 1/8 to Walter Vaughan:

All of my right, title and interest, if any, in the property of the estate of Macie V. Perkinson, deceased, under the first paragraph of her will reading as follows:
