

3. The right-of-way is for the purpose of allowing the Grantee, its successors and assigns, to enter upon the Grantor's tract of land as described above and to construct, maintain and operate a sewer line within said right-of-way.

4. As part of the consideration of this right-of-way, the Grantee agrees that the Grantor shall be given two free residential taps to be used by the Grantor, at any sites and dates selected by the Grantor.

5. It is understood and agreed that during construction of the sewer line it will be necessary to undertake excavation and to clear land and it is further understood that it shall be the duty of the Grantee to clean the construction area after construction is finished and to level the area excavated and to plant grass if desired, so as to return it as nearly as possible to its original condition.
