



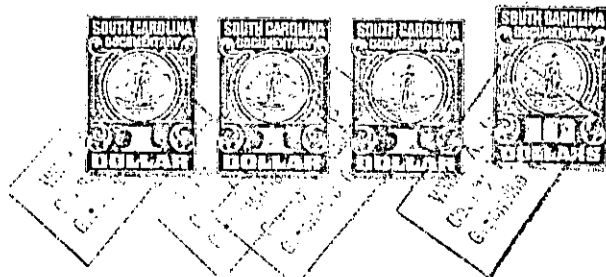

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Cleveland Township, at River Falls, on the west side of Duckworth Road, being known and designated as Lot No. 9 on plat of River Falls, property of D. B. Tripp, recorded in Plat Book G, Page 89, R. M. C. Office for said county.
