One outdoor advertising display 16½ feet by 45 feet on steel eyebeams, approximately 50 feet from ground level, said display being located on the west side of the Church Street Viaduct and south of the main track as identified on the right-of-way and track map of said former Charleston & Western Carolina Railway Company, dated June 30, 1915; said sign was constructed by and now or formerly owned by Creative Displays of Greenville, South Carolina.

5. One outdoor advertising display 14 feet by 48 feet, constructed on steel eyebeams approximately 69 feet from ground level located east of the Church Street Viaduct and north of Tract No. 3, adjacent to the C. Otto White building as identified on right-of-way and track map of said former Charleston & Western Carolina Railway Company, dated June 30, 1915; said display was constructed by and now or formerly owned by Creative Displays of Greenville, South Carolina.

The recitals of fact made herein are to be taken only as recitals made by Grantor and not by Trustees.
