sum of Twenty-three Thousand Nine Hundred (\$23,900.00) -----

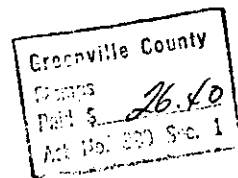

Miller and Catherine Miller, their heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the western side of Sheffield Drive near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 8 as shown on a plat of Canterbury Subdivision, Section I, prepared by Heaner Engineering Co., Inc., dated March 22, 1972, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 4-N at page 69, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Sheffield Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8 and running thence with the line of Lot No. 7 S. 67-38-00 W. 130.0 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 22-22-00 E. 65.51 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 9; thence with the line of Lot No. 9 N. 71-51-31 E. 129.54 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Sheffield Drive; thence with the curve of the western side of Sheffield Drive, the chord of which is N. 20-15-14 W. 22.11 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the western side of said Sheffield Drive N. 22-22-00 W. 52.96 feet to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is subject to all restrictions, zoning ordinances, setback lines, roadways, easements and rights-of-way, if any, affecting the above described property, including restrictions applicable to Canterbury Subdivision, Section I, recorded in the R.M.C.
