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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that C.S. Mattox -----

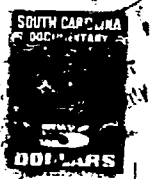
in consideration of Two Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$2,500.00) ----- Dollars,
