KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Charles McCurry Walters

in consideration of Three thousand six hundred sixty-six and 67/100ths-----Dollars,  
(\$3,666.67)

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Thomas O. Lunsford and Ailliene H. Lunsford, their heirs and assigns forever:

All my right, title and interest, the same being a one-third undivided interest in and to that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the South-eastern side of Perry Road in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot 14 on plat of Newlands, prepared by A. S. Beddell, Engineer, dated May 14, 1914, recorded in the RMC Office of the Greenville County Courthouse in Plat Book C at Page 199 and being described, according to said plat, more particularly, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Perry Road at the joint front corner of Lots 13 and 14 and running thence along the Southeastern side of said Road, N 43-12 E 50 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots 14 and 15; thence along the common line of said Lots, S 46-48 E 141.3 feet, more or less, to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of said Lots on the Northern side of a ten-foot alley; thence along said alley, S 43-12 W 50 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 13 and 14; thence along the common line of said Lots, N 46-48 W 142.2 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Perry Road, the point of beginning.

A portion of the Grantor's interest in the above-described property was devised to him by will of Mattie Ferguson Walters as shown in Apartment 1279, File 24 in the Greenville County Probate Court. The remaining portion of said interest was inherited by the Grantor from the Ernest Eula Walters Estate as shown in Apartment 1282, File 11 in the Greenville County Probate Court.

The above-described property is conveyed subject to all restrictions (on back) together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s), and the grantee(s)' heirs, successors and assigns, forever. And, the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)' heirs, successors, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the grantee(s) and the grantee(s)' heirs, successors and assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)' heirs, successors and assigns and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
