

like manner, being able to sell or buy, trade or exchange same as she may see fit.

My power of attorney shall have the right to handle, care for, control, sell and dispose of any property, real or personal, that I may own, and to purchase for me any property, real or personal, and to execute deeds of conveyance.

Giving and granting unto Carolyn B. Galway, said attorney, and her substitute or substitutes, full power and authority to do and perform all and every act as fully to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if personally present, I hereby ratifying and confirming all that Carolyn B. Galway, said attorney, or her substitute or substitutes, shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.

This power of attorney to Carolyn B. Galway revokes the power of attorney given to my nephew, Jack E. W. Galway, executed prior to my marriage to Carolyn B. Galway, which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 875, at page 552.

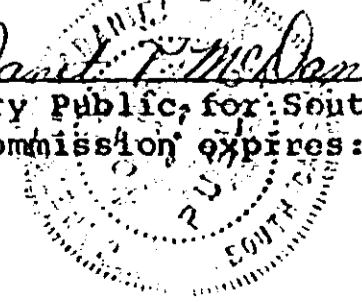
