Regina L. Gilstrap, Her Heirs and Assigns, Forever:

All that lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the eastern side of East Washington Avenue, being known and designated as the northern part of Lot No. 10 and the southern part of Lot No. 11 on Block P, of H. K. Townes property, known as Highland, and shown on plat recorded in Plat Book K at Pages 50-51 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County and being more particularly described according to survey and plat by C. C. Jones, dated February 9, 1957, as follows:
