ALL that lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Town of Fountain Inn, being known as Lot #3, Inn Circle, as shown on a plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQQ, Page 29A,

together with the right and privilege to enter upon the same, from time to time, as shall be necessary and required to maintain and operate the sewerage system of the Town of Fountain Inn, South Carolina.
