

BEGINNING on the Old Baptist Church lot line at the corner of lot no. 4 and runs thence S. 59-30 E. 119.7 feet to the inside edge of the sidewalk on a new street leading from Emma Street to Church Street; thence along this sidewalk S. 33.15 W. 55 feet to the corner of lot no. 2; thence along the line of this lot and lot no. 1, N. 60.15 W. 119 feet to the line of the Old Church property; thence along this line, N. 30.30 E. 55 feet to the beginning corner.
