

foreign countries, subject to the laws of such state, district, territory, colony or country.

To do any or all of the things herein set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do in any part of the world as principals, agents, contractors, or otherwise, and either alone or in connection or in conjunction with others, and, in general, to carry on any other business in connection with the foregoing, whether manufacturing or otherwise; to have and exercise all of the powers conferred by the State of Delaware upon corporations, pursuant to the General Corporation Law of the State of Delaware, and the acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto.

The foregoing clauses should be construed both as objects and powers and it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict, in any manner, the powers of this corporation.

FOURTH: The total number of shares of stock which the Corporation shall have authority to issue is 1,000; all of such shares shall be without par value and all of the same class. Each share of stock shall be equal in every respect to the other share of stock and shall be entitled to equal voting rights, dividends, and in case of distribution of assets, to equal aliquot parts of such assets, share and share alike.

FIFTH: The amount of capital with which the corporation will commence business is One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000).
