and Public Transportation (herewith State Highway Department) File No. 23.730, Route 25/276, it being our further intention for this Receipt and Release to cover any adverse drainage conditions on our remainder property caused or contributed to by the highway reconstruction project in question, as well as any damages resulting from the maintenance of said highway project by the South Carolina Department of Highways and Public Transportation.

The undersigned J. E. Austin further hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the South Carolina Department of Highways and Public Transportation for any and all claims of a similar nature which might be asserted by any persons alleging to claim any interest in the real estate which is the subject of this condemnation acquisition, and which is the subject of this Release, which claims might be asserted by persons or corporations alleging to claim an interest in the real estate which is the subject of this Release, on account of or in any way growing out of the condemnation and reconstruction of the highway in question.

We do, further, hereby grant to our attorney, William D. Richardson, full and complete authority to consent to such order or orders as may be necessary to dismiss and forever end the above entitled condemnation proceeding. Finally, we state that we have read and fully understand the foregoing General Receipt and Release.
