- damage that may be occasioned by or through the acts or omissions of persons occupying adjoining premises occupying the pearby Shopping Center or any persons transacting any business in said Shopping Center or present therein for any other purpose, or for any loss or damage resulting to Tenent or its property from burst, stopped or leaking water, gas, sewer or steam pipes or plumbing fixtures or from any failure of or defect in any electric line, circuit or facility.
- (m) That it will surrender the leased premises at the termination of this lease in as good condition as they shall be in at the beginning, reasonable wear and tear and damage by casualty alone excepted.
  - 10. The Landlord covenants and agrees:
- (a) That it has the legal right to enter into this lease and that it will put
  the Tenant in actual possession of the leased premises at the beginning of the aforesaid term and that said Tenant, so long as it pays the rent and performs the covenants
  on its part herein set out, shall and may peaceably and quietly have, hold and enjoy the
  leased premises for the full :term hereof.
