In consideration of Eighteen Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Five and 35/100 (\$18,365.35)--- Dollars and assumption of mortgage set out below the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto James P. Mullinnix, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the northwestern side of Rutledge Avenue, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being shown and designated as Lot 114 on plat of "Property of J. P. Rosamond" prepared by Dalton & Neeves Engineers, and recorded in the RIC Office for Greenville County, S. C., April 30, 1931, in Plat Book H, pages 185 and 186, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
