KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Kevin Reid Chamblee

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Nadine Chamblee, her heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the easterly side of Central Street, now known as Briarcliff Drive in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina in East Overbrook Subdivision and being shown as lot no. 11 on a plat entitled PROPERTY OF W. E. PHELPS made by C. M. Furman, Jr. recorded in Plat Book F at Page 46 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Central Street (now known as Briarcliff Drive) corner of lot no. 13, which pin is 240 feet N. 43-45 E. from the intersection of Westview Road and Central Street, and running thence with line of lot no. 13, S. 36-38 E. 199 feet to a stake on 15 foot alley; thence N. 42-35 E. with said alley, 60 feet to a stake, corner of lot no. 10; thence with the line of lot no. 10, N. 36-38 W. 199 feet to stake in Central Street; thence with Central Street, S. 43-45 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.

The above property is the same property conveyed to Manning Wilson Chamblee by deed of Annie Belle Chamblee recorded April 6, 1940 in Deed Book 220 at Page 189 and is hereby conveyed subject to all rights of way, easements, conditions, public roads and restrictive covenants reserved on plats and other instruments of public record and actually existing on the ground affecting said property. The said Manning Wilson Chamblee died intestate on August 8, 1969, a resident of Prince Georges County, Maryland, leaving as his heirs and next of kin, his wife, Nadien Chamblee, the grantee herein, and three children, namely Mark Wilson Chamblee, Alvin John Chamblee and William Kent Chamblee. William Kent Chamblee died intestate on April 22, 1974, a resident of San Antonio, Texas, leaving as his heirs and next of kind his wife, Barbara Ann Chamblee, and one child, namely, Kevin Reid Chamblee. There has been no administration of the estate of Manning Wilson Chamblee due to the limited amount of property owned by the deceased, and all debts of the estate have been paid. There has been no administration of the Estate of William Kent Chamblee due to the limited amount of property owned by the deceased, and all debts of the estate have been paid.
